The management of Dothan Boots & Saddle Club - Little Spurs Rodeo, reserves the right to excuse persons for conduct distracting to the enjoyment by others in attendance.

All pictures (that may include my child) taken by Dothan Boots & Saddle Club photographer will become the property of Dothan Boots & Saddle Club for advertisement, the club website or club promotions.

If it rains on rodeo day no refunds will be made under any circumstances. If rain is light and or brief, the rodeo will continue as the weather passes if at all possible. If unable to continue the Little Spurs Rodeo will be rescheduled and the paid fees will be carried over to the rescheduled rodeo date.

My child(ren) are covered by a personal or family medical insurance policy, and I may be required to show proof of the said insurance. Dothan Boots & Saddle Club is released from liability and responsibility of any personal injury while participating on the property.

All participants must be able to perform the requirements of the event without adult assistance. Even if a contest is unable to complete or correctly finish an event the contestant will receive 2 points for an attempt/try.

No horses will be allowed to be ridden on the grounds while the NON-HORSE events are taking place. They must be stalled (\$10 stall fee) or tied to the horse trailer. Horses must not be left unattended unless they are securely stalled or loaded in a trailer.

Contestants may not be in the arena/event area unless they have been called for an upcoming event. Only DBSC personnel will be allowed in the arena/ with the participants. Parents or guardians will be allowed in certain areas at the discretion of DBSC personnel.

The registration booth closes at 9:30 AM rodeo day. No new registration or changes will be allowed after that time. Contestants will be given a back number at registration and will not be allowed to compete without a back number

All contestants are responsible for reporting to the arena/Event area at the appointed time for the events they are registered in. If a contestant fails to report at the appointed time, the announcer or arena director will give him/her three (3) calls. After the 3rd call, the contestant will be scratched from that event as a "no show."
